

Centennial Lecture Series: Secular Morality and the University, Prof. Emmanuel de Dios, May 7, NISMED Auditorium, 2 p.m.



Prof. Emmanuel S. De Dios is the current dean of the UP School of Economics (SE).

Prior to his appointment as dean of SE, he was chair of the SE Department of Economics for the periods November 1989 to March 1991; June 1995 to May 1997; June 1998 to May 2000; December 2006 to April 2007 and May to August 2007.

After graduating from Ateneo de Manila University with a degree in Economics in 1978, cum laude, he was given a graduate fellowship by the SE from 1978 to 1979.

He first joined UPD as an Instructor from 1980 to 1984 and diligently worked his way up until he became Director of the European Studies Programme of the UP Center of Integrative and Development Studies (UP-CIDS) from January 1996 to May 2000.

In September 2000, De Dios was invited by St. Norbert College in De Pere, Wisconsin as a Visiting professor for the Fall Term. He returned to SE in May 2003 and served as Director for Fellowships and Graduate Admissions until May 2005.

Current Trustee and treasurer of the prestigious Ramón Magsaysay Awards Foundation, De Dios is also a Research Fellow of Pulse Asia and Executive Director of the ASEAN Free Trade Area Advisory Commission. He also serves as chair of the Commission on Higher Education's Technical Committee for Economics, Sub-panel on Humanities, Social Sciences and Communications.

His expertise and achievements were not left unnoticed. In 1984, he was given a Catholic Mass Media Award (Best Book in English) for his work An Analysis of the Philippine Economic Crisis: A Workshop Report.

In 2006 he was given the Gawad Chanselor sa Natatanging Guro (Outstanding Teacher), the highest teaching award in UPD. Thematic Lecture: Anthropogenic Global Warming, Prof. Perry Ong, May 14, NISMED Auditorium, 2 p.m.



Prof. Perry S. Ong is a professor in wildlife biology and is the current director of Institute of Biology, College of Science.

Ong is currently the president of the Wildlife Conservation Society of the Philippines and of the Earth Rights, People's Rights Inc. He also sits as a member of the board of trustees of Philippine Tropical Forest Conservation Inc.

Ong earned his BS and MS in Zoology from UP Los Baños in 1983 and 1988, respectively. In 1995, he obtained his Ph.D. in Behavioral Ecology and Evolutionary Biology at the Monash University, Australia.

An associate editor of the Raffles Bulletin of Zoology at the National University of Singapore, Ong has written numerous papers and articles which he has presented in local and international conferences. Moreover, his research works were published in respected and prestigious international and local scientific jpiurnals and publications.

He likewise lends his expertise to organizations, serving as consultant or undertaking commission research for the World Bank, United Nations Development Programme, Southeast Asian Mammal Database, and the Department of Environment and Natural Resources.

A Research Associate at the Field Museum, Chicago, Illionios, Ong was chosen as one of the Ten Outstanding Young Men by the Philippine Jaycees in 2000. That same year he was awarded the Outstanding Young Scientist by the National Academy of Science and Technology (NAST).

His other distinctions include the 2004
Hugh Greenwood Award for Environmental
Science by the NAST and the Gawad
Chanselor sa Pinakamahusay na Aklat in
1999. In 1995, Ong was chosen as a finalist at
the ASEAN Young Scientist and Technologist
Award by the ASEAN Awards Committee
under the National Academy of Science
and Technology and was given special prize
at the Philippine Talent Search for Young
Scientists by the NAST.

Ramón R. del Rosario Jr. is the President of Philippine Investment Management (PHINMA), Inc. and Bacnotan Consolidated Industries, Inc., two affiliated companies with investments in housing, education, energy, financial services and steel roofing. He is also Chairman and Chief Executive Officer of AB Capital and Investment Corporation, a full-service investment bank and Chairman of Microtel Inns and Suites (Pilipinas), Inc.

He serves on the Boards of Directors of Ayala Land, Inc., Holcim, Roxas Holdings, Inc. and Bacnotan Consolidated Industries, which are listed on the Philippine Stock Exchange, and Nasdag-listed PSi Technologies, Inc. He served previously as Chief Financial Officer of San Miguel Corporation and as director in Petron Corporation and Meralco. Del Rosario served as the Philippines' Secretary of Finance under President Fidel V. Ramos from 1992 to 1993. Del Rosario is a graduate of Harvard Business School, He graduated from De La Salle University, Manila with an AB-BSC degree, magna cum laude.

He was high-school and elementary school Valedictorian at De La Salle College. He was the 1978 Ten Outstanding Young Men (TOYM) awardee in the field of Investment Banking and Finance and was selected as the Most Outstanding Student of the Philippines in 1967.

He is currently Chairman of the Board of Trustees of De La Salle University, Manila, Chairman of the Board of Regents of the De La Salle University System, and Chairman of Araullo University. He is Chairman of the Philippines-U.S. Business Council, Chairman of the Board of Trustees of the Philippine Educational Theater Association and of the Philippine National Museum Foundation; Chairman of the Coalition against Corruption, and member of the boards of trustees of the Asian Institute of Management.

The 97th General Commencement Exercises

he 97th General Commencement Exercises is a date with history as it happens during the Centenary Year of the University. Dubbed as the Centennial Commencement Exercises, it unfolds on April 27, 2008 at the University Amphitheater with the theme: 100 Years of Excellence, Leadership and Service.

The academic rites of passage is made doubly celebratory with 15 students graduating with the highest honors the University can confer. The number is the biggest haul of honor graduates in the history of the University.

Invited to address the centennial graduates is Regent Abraham F. Sarmiento who belonged to the first class that held its commencement exercises in the Diliman campus after the historic transfer of the University from Padre Faura in late 1948 to February of 1949.

Sarmiento obtained his AA in 1941 and his LLB in 1949, both from the University of the Philippines. He was admitted to the Philippine Bar on May 16, 1950.

A legal luminary in the fields of human rights and individual liberty, Sarmiento literally rose from the ranks from his early stint as Law Clerk at the Paredes & Poblador Law Offices after his graduation from the University to his being appointed by President Corazón C. Aquino as Associate Justice of the Supreme Court of the Philippines on January 26, 1987. He occupies No. 119 in the Roster of Supreme Court Justices of the Philippines since June 11, 1901.
