



EXHIBIT AND BOOK LAUNCHES

Lineage of Mentors: The National Artists for the Visual Arts of the University of the Philippines is an art exhibit featuring the works of the nine National Artists for Visual Arts from UP namely: Fernando Cueto Amorsolo, Guillermo Estrella Tolentino, Carlos Villaluz Francisco, Napoleon Veloso Abueva, Vicente Silva Manansala, Cesar Torrente Legaspi, José Tanig Joya, Benedicto Reyes Cabrera and Abdulmari Asia Imao. The works are from the collections of the University and the National Museum of the Philippines. The exhibit is held at the Hall of National Artists for Visual Arts at the 2nd level of the National Art Gallery, National Museum, Manila. It runs from June 11 until the end of December 2008.

Accompanying the exhibit is a commemorative book entitled Forming Lineage: The National Artists for the Visual Arts of the University of the Philippines.

The opening essay, written by Prof. Ruben D.F. Defeo, is a historical synopsis of the College of Fine Arts where all the nine National Artists obtained their academic

training in the arts. It chronicles the development of the academic unit from the Escuela de Bellas Artes in the 1800s to the period it was called the School of Fine Arts during the first five decades of the 1900s to its merger with architecture in the 1960s when it was known as the College of Architecture and Fine Arts and finally to its becoming as the College of Fine Arts in the 1970s. The historical retelling bares the transformation of the school from its atelier beginnings following the ideals of European academies to a dynamic unit that exposes

JUNE 19: Unibersidad ng Pilipinas, Pag-asa ng Bayan, Prof. Cecilia A. Florencio, NISMED Auditorium, 2 p.m.



Prof. Cecilia A. Florencio is a retired University Professor of the College of Home Economics (CHE). Prior to her retirement, she served as dean of CHE from 1990 to 1996 and chair of the Department of Food Science and Nutrition from 1971 to 1972.

Among her many awards and recognitions in the University are: UP Scientist III (2006), UP International Publication Award (2000, 2002, 2004), President's Diploma for Outstanding Extension/Community Service (1988), President's Diploma for Outstanding Teacher (1988), Professorial Award in Nutrition by the UP Alumni Association (1985), and Distinguished Record of Achievement in Nutrition by the UP CHE Alumni Association (1984).

In the national level, she was recognized as one of the Filipino Women in Health Sciences 1900-2000 by the National Academy of Science and Technology (2000). Florencio was also given the Special Award in Nutrition and as one of the Thirty Leaders in Nutrition-Dietetics in the Philippines by the Nutritionists-Dietitians Association of the Philippines, both in 1985.

Florencio also served as a member of the Panel of Eminent Experts on Ethics in Food Nutrition and Agriculture of the Food and Agriculture Organization based in Rome from 2004 to 2007, and the Virtual Network of Experts to assist in the Implementation of the Global Strategy on Diet, Physical Activity and Health, a project of the World Health Organization in 2004.

Florencio earned her BSHE from UP in 1961; her MS in Nutrition from University of Iowa, USA in 1964; and her Ph.D. in Nutrition from Michigan State University, East Lanching, Michigan, USA in 1967.
