## Atelyer opens at the Bulwagan ng Dangal

A new art venue opens on campus on October 15.


alled Atelyer, the venue is the latest addition to the growing number of art exhibition spaces in UP Diliman. It is located within the Bulwagan ng Dangal, the University Heritage Museum which opened last June this year.

The gallery within the museum is a 1,568 sq.ft space, with a 14 ft. wall area of 212 ft. long and equipped with both ambient and focused lighting.

For its inaugural show, Atelyer presents the vintage works of Lito Carating, an alumnus of the College of Fine Arts, known for his sleek metallic abstractions. Included in the show are Carating's students works dating as early as 1969, as well as his award winning pieces in local art competitions. Other works include his early forays in painting like the Lamanglupa series of the 1970s, the Anilao underwater series of 1980s and his abracts expressionist works of the 1990s. A portrait of the artist done by National Artist José Joya ushers the exhibit. The exhibit, curated by Professor Rubén D.F. Defeo, will run until December 31.

The collection belongs to the artist who has kept the pieces through the years in his Del Monte studio in Quezon City. Some of them have never been exhibited in public. The collection, including the Joya portrait, will be bequeathed by the artist to the University to jumpstart the UP Contemporary Art Collection under the management of the Office for Initiatives in Culture and the Arts.

A consistent winner in practically all the national art competitions, including the 13 Artists award from the Cultural Center of the Philippines, Carating has represented the country in various international art events. He has extensively exhibited from coast to coast in the United States and Canada, and most recently in Spain, as well as in Cuba, China, Dubai, Hong Kong and Singapore.


