PRESIDENTIAL DECREE NO. 232

CREATING A PHILIPPINE COCONUT AUTHORITY

WHEREAS, the Coconut Industry has attained magniudes that necessitate a more concerted effort at integrating the diffused efforts currently being exerted towards its deve-

WHEREAS, the global perspective on international fats and oil supply situation indicates a need for developing other industrial and food uses of coconut through a more purposeful and integrated research activity;

WHEREAS, the present stage of the development of the coconut and other palm oils in the country is generally charac-

On 19 June 1971, Marcos Sr. signed Republic Act 6260, otherwise known as the Coconut Investment Fund. The law put into motion a taxation scheme that promised to fund the development of the coconut industry in the country. As a result, Filipino coconut farmers, who were already living in abject poverty, faced heavy taxes on their produce and saw reduced farm incomes. The multibillion fund was diverted by Marcos cronies, and to this day today, has not benefited the coconut farmers.

Noong 19 Hunyo 1971, nilagdaan ni Marcos Sr. ang Republic Act 6260 na mas kilala bilang Coconut Investment Fund. Isinulong ng nasabing batas ang pagbuo ng iskema ng pagbubuwis na naglalayong palaguin ang industriya ng niyog sa bansa.
